**Block unwelcome calls
with Nomorobo.**



Nomorobo is a service that can help block robocalls and telemarketers from calling your **Digital Voice** home phone. This third-party service identifies known robocallers and telemarketers and stops your Digital Voice home phone from ringing. The good news is that Nomorobo is free, easy to sign up with, and works as promised. I used to get at least one or two robocalls per day. The only sign of them now is that the phone rings once. If I'm curious, I can go to my Caller ID and check the calling number. So far, every blocked call has been from a known robocaller.

Setting up a Nomorobo account is simple and free: Go to nomorobo.com and signup. Nomorobo can all but eliminate robocalls and the annoyances that come with them. (Thanks for calling, Rachel, but I don't want your important information about my credit card.) The company behind it-Telephone Science-makes its money from providing its database of robocalling numbers to carriers like Ooma Premier and Sonic, which use it as part their own robocall-blocking service.

As anyone who's put their phone number on the Federal Trade Commission's (FTC) National Do Not Call Registry knows, being on the list does very little to eliminate unwanted calls. Legitimate companies may follow the rules, but scam artists couldn't care less about them. They regularly spoof Caller IDs so you can't tell where the call originates. Ask them to take you off their call list, and they'll typically hang up on you, leaving you wishing that you hadn't been so polite. And they won't take you off the list either. **Nomorobo is free for landlines and costs \$1.99 for mobile phones.**




Sam's Club Scan & Go

How does Scan & Go work?

- Download the Scan & Go app on your iPhone and open it when you're inside the club.
- Get what you need and scan each barcode as you add items to your cart.
- No barcode? Quickly look up items with the "Find an Item" feature.
- See the running total of items in your cart as you shop.
- Check out and pay in the app when you're done shopping.
- Show your e-receipt on your iPhone to the greeter when you're ready to go.

Google Photos



Google Photos is an incredible app with a ton of features. A suite of editing tools allows users to perform basic editing functions for photos and videos, automatically adjust settings such as exposure, white balance, saturation, contrast, etc. as well as apply filters and more. The app will automatically generate smart albums that showcase your best photos from an event or trip (even inviting your friends to add photos into the album), and it features automatically created collages, movies, GIFs, panoramas, and more from your photos. A powerful search engine allows users to search for photos throughout their entire library by the people included in the photos, the places they are taken, or even the things showcased in them, such as a snowstorm, fireworks, etc. Sounds great, doesn't it? Well, on top of all that, Google Photos provides every user with free unlimited cloud storage of all of your photos and videos (up to 16MP for photos and 1080p quality for videos), easily

shareable and accessible from any device. Yes, you read that right, free. Even if you're a fan of the default iOS Photos app (which, once again, is a solid app), the free cloud storage should lead you to download this app immediately. [Download Here](#)

Charge Your iPhone Faster*



1. Turn on Airplane Mode

While your iPhone is connected to a charger, presumably replenishing its battery, the device is actually *expending battery power* while plugged in. That's because the device is still connected to, and processing data from, cellular, Wi-Fi, Bluetooth, and other wireless connections. However if you turn

your iPhone's Airplane Mode *on* while charging, you're bound to notice that the device is able to charge up noticeably faster. The only drawback to doing this, of course, would be that you wouldn't receive calls or texts, while Airplane Mode is enabled.

To enable **Airplane Mode**:

- 1 Swipe up from the bottom of the screen
- 2 Tap the **Airplane** icon on the top row of options in control panel.

2. Use an Upgraded Charger

The Apple-branded charger included with recent iPhones features a 5-volt configuration, capable of pushing 1 amp at 5 watts of power. But compare the iPhone's charger, for example, with what Cupertino includes with every iPad - a 5.1-volt configuration, capable of pushing 2.1 amps at 12 watts of power. If you used an iPad charger to charge your iPhone, you'd be able to do so in a lot less time. Bottom line is: not all chargers are created equal. And you will be surprised at just how much faster you can charge your iPhone by using a more powerful charger.


3. Power Down Completely While Charging

This tip runs somewhat along the lines of enabling Airplane mode, as noted in our first tip. However, instead of merely disabling the myriad of wireless connectivity options, fully powering down your iPhone altogether will not only allow it to juice up faster, but will also help ensure the temperature is nice and cool throughout the duration of the process.
