For many months Little Rock SeniorNet has had a problem with students registering for classes and then not showing up for the class. If a registered student fails to attend the class, and has a reasonable excuse, the payment can be applied to a future class. To confirm a reservation for a class, a check or money order must be returned to SeniorNet with the registration form.

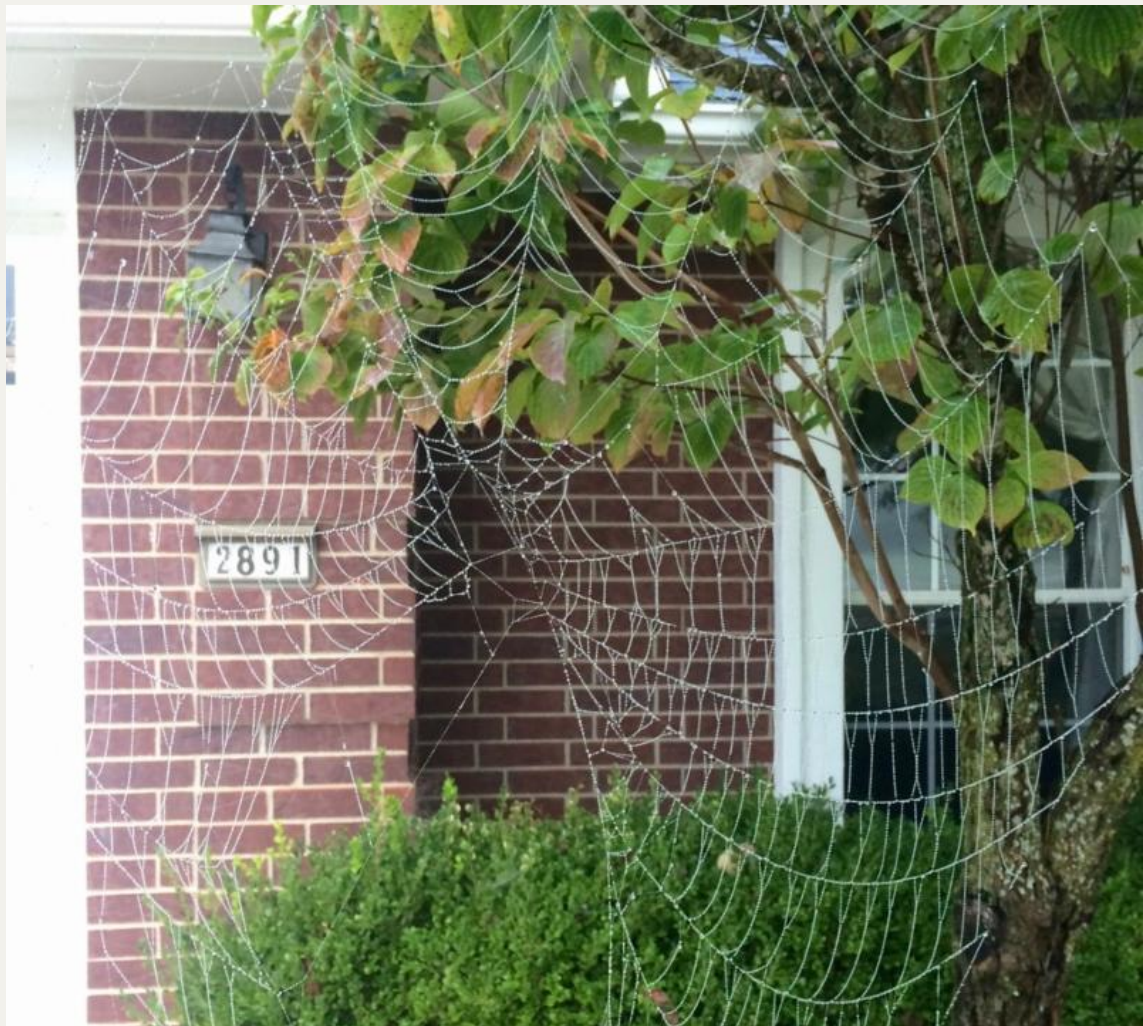
